

VISA

Nationals of countries subject to the visa requirement need to procure an entry visa for Croatia. The visa application must be submitted to the diplomatic mission or consulate of the Republic of Croatia in the foreign national's home country. RESIDENCE PERMIT

Hotels and student dormitories register their foreign guests with the Primorsko-Goranska County Police Administration. Foreign citizens staying at an apartment should register their address or change of address in person at the Primorsko-Goranska County Police Administration **within forty-eight hours upon arrival (weekends excluded)**.
